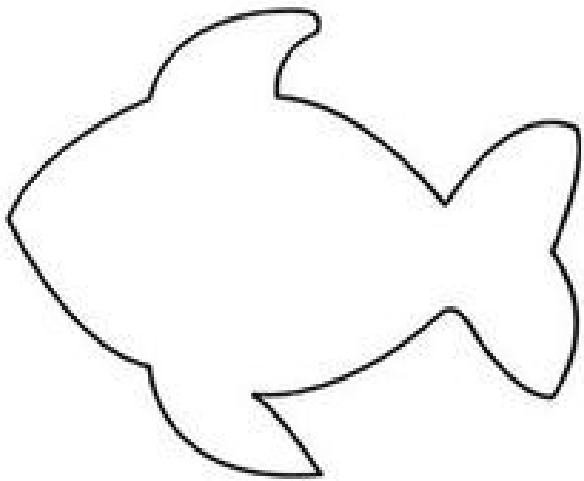


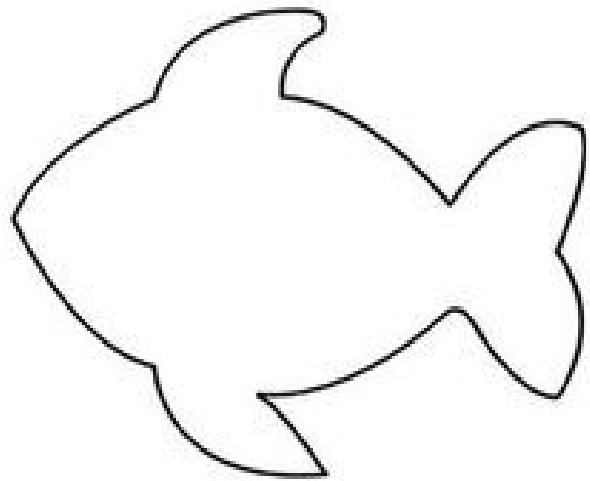


In Class Activity Sheet – Why are Coral Reefs so Colourful?

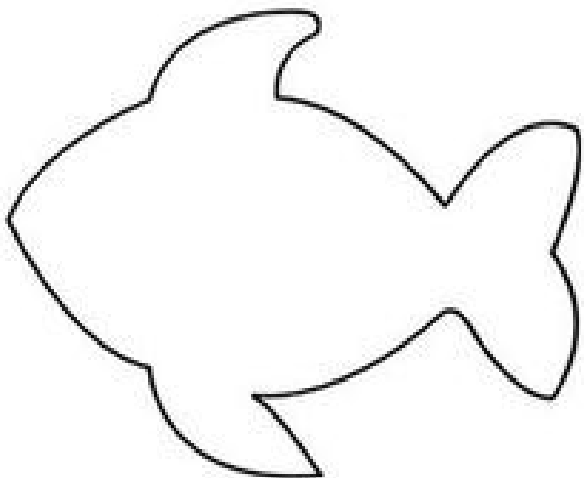

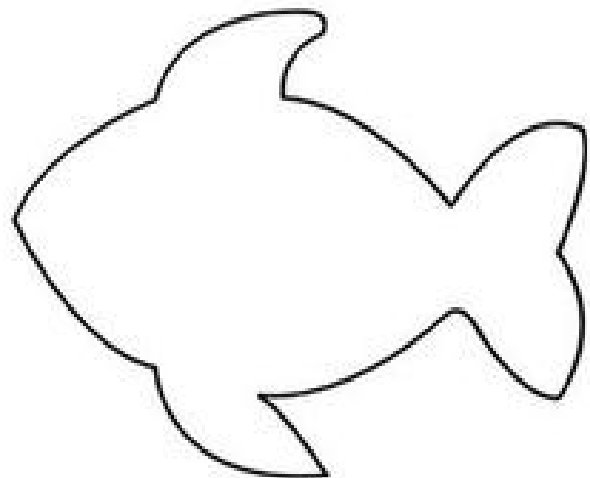
Countershading
