

Support the Coral Fund

CCMI continues to look to the horizon and the future of what we do with the highly anticipated start of construction on our new facility in Little Cayman! This additional site will allow us to double our capacity, host visiting education and research efforts simultaneously, and significantly increase our impact for coral reefs.

Last year, our special fund-a-need component of Festival of Seas raised nearly US \$30,000 for the Coral Fund, helping us raise almost US \$2 million of the US \$2.9 million needed, which allows us to begin planning in earnest for the build.

However, we still need to raise nearly US \$1 million to fully fund the construction and kitting out of the facility, and we continue to seek support of the Coral Fund capital campaign to get us to our goal.
