letter from the field

Dear Friends and Ocean Advocates,

We love to admire the beauty of the reefs across all three islands —an intricate, living tapestry that has sustained marine life and coastal communities for generations. But beneath the surface, we are witnessing changes that are happening faster than ever before, changes that are accelerated by human activity both locally and around the world.

Coral reefs everywhere are struggling under the weight of climate change. Recordbreaking ocean temperatures over the last few years have pushed corals to their limits. Bleaching events, once rare, are becoming more frequent and severe. The vibrant, resilient ecosystems we rely on are being tested in ways we have never seen before.

At the Central Caribbean Marine Institute (CCMI), we are racing against time. Our research has never been more timely or urgent, as we work to understand how corals are adapting, where they are finding refuge, and what we can do to ensure their survival. Our efforts to find impactful, scalable solutions to declines in coral health is expanding, now moving to new depths as we discover potential of coral resiliency in cooler, deeper waters. Studying coral reefs at these deeper depths may hold the key to coral survival, offering an insight into a refuge where corals can continue to thrive despite the challenges at the surface.



Support the Coral Fund

CCMI is moving forward with our plans to expand our Little Cayman facilities, which moves us toward our goal of doubling our capacity for research and education. We will build a new 11,000 sq. ft. facility dedicated to research and education, which will allow us to run education courses and research programmes simultaneously, reaching more students and marine scientists than ever before.

With a goal of raising USD \$3.9 million for Phase 1 of the build (over 5,000 sq. ft), we are already more than halfway there, having



secured approximately USD \$1.9 million.

Last year, our special fund-a-need component of Festival of Seas raised more than US \$30,000 for the Coral Fund.

We still need to raise ~US \$1 million to fully fund the construction (anticipated start in early 2026) and kitting out of the facility. Your support is crucial for us to complete this project as we continue to evolve as a regional leader in marine research and education.
